

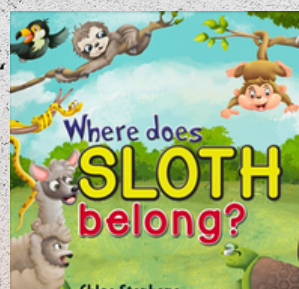

- Open space for the children to sit and move around



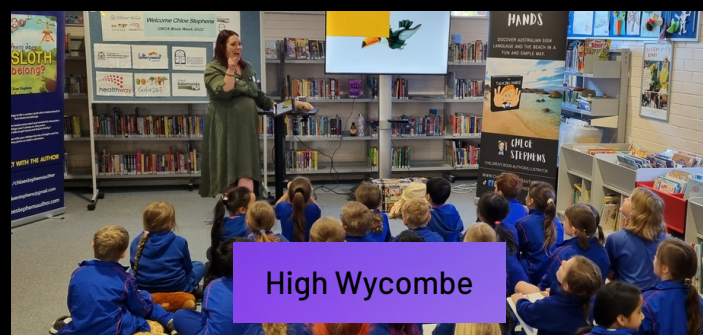


# CHLOE'S WORKSHOP REVIEWS

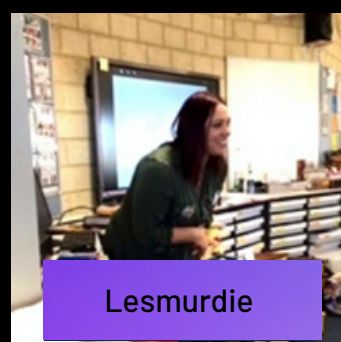
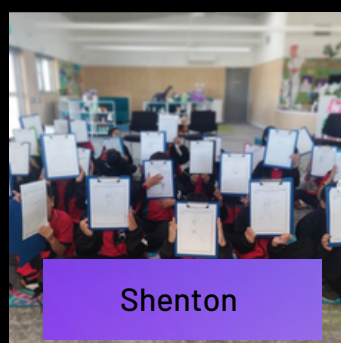
